Banquet Tickets On Sale!



Tickets will be on sale in the concessions stand at this Sunday's game. The 2007 Banquet is being held at the Diplomat Party House on Saturday November 17th. Players and cheerleaders are complimentary, and they will get their tickets at the equipment hand in on November 11th.

There is a limit on purchased tickets to 2 per family @ \$15 ea. After Sunday we will open tickets to additional family members. Including other adults (grandparents, etc.) and Raiders alumni (older brothers and sisters) as in the past the banquet is not for younger siblings. Keep in mind that there is a limit on how many tickets are available so make sure you purchase your tickets before they are gone.

The 2007 cheerleading security deposits cannot be applied to banquet ticket purchases. The security deposits will be refunded after equipment hand-in. If you are registering your child for next season, you may roll the security deposit over to next year.



AYFCL Annual Cheerleading Tournament – Sat 10/20 @ 9:40am (Doors open 8:30 am)

Come out and support all of our cheerleaders as they participate in the annual AYFCL competition at R.I.T. Gordon's Field House. The event begins with the National Anthem at 9:40 am with the Flag girls exhibition beginning at 9:45 am. **The doors will open at 8:30 am.** Cost is \$5 per person. Football players get in FREE if they wear their game Jersey. 5 and under are also FREE. Please arrive early.

Cheerleaders should look for their coaches when they arrive. Coaches will gather up the teams and take the girls in separately. AYFCL Cheerleaders and coaches get in for Free.

Directions to R.I.T. (Distance: 19 miles Travel Time: 30 minutes):

1. Start at **1300 HILTON PARMA CORNERS RD, PARMA** - go 2.4 mi
2. Continue on **N UNION ST(RT-259)** - go 2.9 mi
3. Turn **L** to take ramp onto **RT-531 E** toward **I-490** - go 5.0 mi
4. Take the **I-490 E L** exit onto **I-490 E** - go 1.9 mi
5. Take exit **#9B/AIRPORT** onto **I-390 S** - go 2.9 mi
6. Take exit **#17/SCOTTSVILLE RD.** toward **RT-383 S** - go 0.2 mi
7. Turn **R** on **SCOTTSVILLE RD(RT-383)** - go 2.8 mi
8. Turn **L** on **RT-252** - go 0.4 mi
9. Turn **R** on **LOMB MEMORIAL DR** - go 0.5 mi
10. Arrive at **1 LOMB MEMORIAL DR, HENRIETTA**, on the **L**

2008 Registration Information

The Hilton Raiders organization is changing the way we handle registrations. The waiting list is being discontinued.

RETURNING PLAYERS & NEW SIBLINGS: All returning players (and new siblings) for all squads (Flag, C, B, and A) must register between now and January 15th 2008. You will receive your complete registration package details shortly. The packets will also be available on the website. You must turn in the completed AYFCL contract and full registration fees by 1/15/2008 or your spot will not be saved.

NEW PLAYERS: New players are eligible to register 1/16/2008. Registration for new players will be on a first come first serve basis. Full registration fees are required in order to register. Once a squad is full, it will be posted on our website. If a squad is full, we will maintain a small waiting list should a player decide to drop out before the season starts.

Football Players:

Flag Teams: 5, 6 and 7 yr olds
C-Team:** 7, 8 and 9 yr olds – up to 105 lbs.
B-Team:** 8*, 9, 10 and 11 yr olds – up to 125 lbs.
A-Team: 10, 11, 12 and 13 yr olds – up to 155 lbs.
 14 yr old lightweights - up to 120 lbs.

*8 yr olds will be allowed on a case-by-case basis on B Team and must be approved by the President & AYFCL.

** Lightweights have been removed from "C" and "B"
